Lesson format are group lessons of no more than 4 riders with two sessions on Saturday: one on the flat and one over fences. Sunday will be one mounted session to work on skills from Saturday. Lessons will be an hour and 15 minutes long.

Groups will be set up as follows:

Assessment: 2010 Upper Level candidates will be grouped together and will receive verbal and written assessments on their readiness to rate and areas in which to concentrate their efforts towards their rating.

Clinic: C1 and up members are welcome to participate in their own group(s). Emphasis will be on riding skills and position work.

On Sunday afternoon we will also host a **Teaching to Teach clinic** with time spent in the classroom working on teaching theory and will move on to teach mounted Pony Club lessons. Open to C1 rated ponyclubbers and up.

Space is limited to 12 participants so get your entries in as soon as possible! Entry deadline is November 1st. Limited overnight stabling is available for Friday and Saturday nights. Stalls will be pre-bedded and need to be stripped upon departure.
